

Klahaya Code of Conduct

Klahaya Swim and Tennis Club is a family oriented club. Our main focus is to encourage our children to be involved in safe, fun and educational swim and tennis programs. We want to encourage everyone involved to respect each other and our opponents throughout the summer swim league and tennis season.

In order to ensure that everyone has a fun summer we (families and coaches) agree to:

- Follow all Klahaya rules and policies
 - Complete the **Klahaya Emergency Medical Form** for each child
 - Complete the forms required for swim and tennis team participants
 - Pay all dues, assessments and fees prior to participation

- Treat everyone (coaches, parents, children, officials, volunteers, competitors) with respect and display a high level of sportsmanship at all times.
This includes but is not limited to:
 - Supporting all athletes (Klahaya players and opponents)
 - Encouraging fair play
 - Speaking with respect and consideration – using appropriate language
 - Exercising self-control. Accept decisions and abide by them. Refrain from vulgar language and unsportsmanlike conduct.
 - Communicating with coaches or parents at appropriate times (not while the children are being coached)
 - Refraining from making derogatory comments towards coaches, parents and children
 - Picking up after yourselves and others as needed (matches, meets and lessons)

- Help the children respect their coaches and teammates by:
 - Notifying the coaches in writing (as soon as possible) when a child will miss a swim meet or tennis match
 - Encouraging the children to communicate their concerns to their coach
 - Helping the youngest children to get to events on time and encouraging them to participate in the entire competition- especially swimming relay teams since 3 other children are involved
 - Helping the children get to practice on time
 - Ensuring that children come dressed in team attire for all meets and matches

- Volunteer as much as you are able:
 - At each home swim meet or tennis match
 - As needed throughout the summer season
